## The Beebles of Blopple

### About the Story

*The Beebles of Blopple* is a whimsical rhyming children's story about curiosity, kindness, and the discovery of friendship in unexpected places. When Emma spends a quiet afternoon beneath her favorite tree, she meets Bimble, a tiny creature from the magical world of Blopple.

Through Emma's discovery, readers are introduced to the Beebles—curious little creatures who live quietly nearby but can only be seen by those with the kindest hearts.

### Key Themes

Teachers may wish to explore themes such as:

- kindness and empathy
- curiosity and imagination
- friendship
- noticing the world around us
- believing in wonder

### Discussion Questions

1. Why do you think Emma was able to see the Beebles?
2. What do you think makes someone kind?
3. If you discovered a Beeble, what would you ask them?
4. Where do you think Beebles might hide in our world?
5. What kind of adventures might Emma and the Beebles have next?

### Creative Classroom Activity

Invite students to draw their own Beeble and imagine where it might live in the magical world of Blopple.

Students can also create new locations for Blopple and add them to their own world map.
